Palmer's College Prize-winners 2017

The Palmer's College Annual Prize-giving Ceremony was held on Friday 4th November 2017 at the Civic Hall in Grays. The event was attended by a number of local dignitaries including Mayor Cllr Tunde Ojetola, sponsors, staff and friends of the College and the families of the prize winners. The majority of the prizes are donated by the William Palmer Educational Trust, who generously gives financial help each year to the students as well as prize money. All other prizes are donated by local businesses and individuals.

On arrival, guests were entertained with a musical presentation by the BTEC Performing Arts students. Dan Pearson, the new Principal, then offered a general welcome and invited Brian Little, Chairman of the Trust, to talk about the history and the work of the Trust. Mr Pearson then introduced our guest speaker for the evening, **Amy Kean**. Amy, a former Palmer's College student, (1997 – 1999) is now Vice President of Strategy and Planning for Beamly, an in-house agency that sits within the big beauty powerhouse, Coty. Coty own brands worldwide such as Rimmel, Cover Girl and Max Factor. Amy gave a very lively account of her time at Palmer's and later at the University of Bath where she obtained a BSC in Sociology and Psychology; she then presented the prize winners with their certificates.
